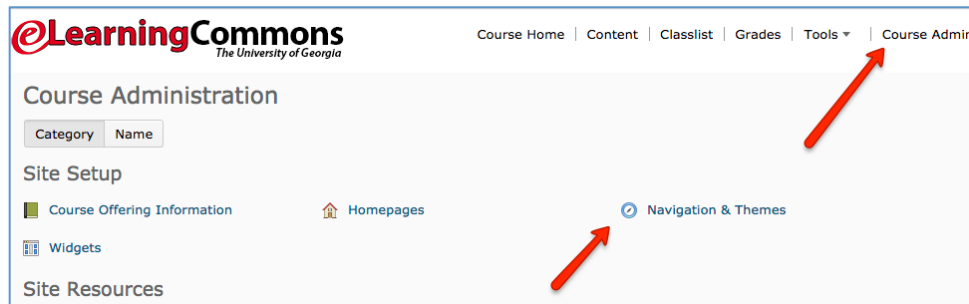
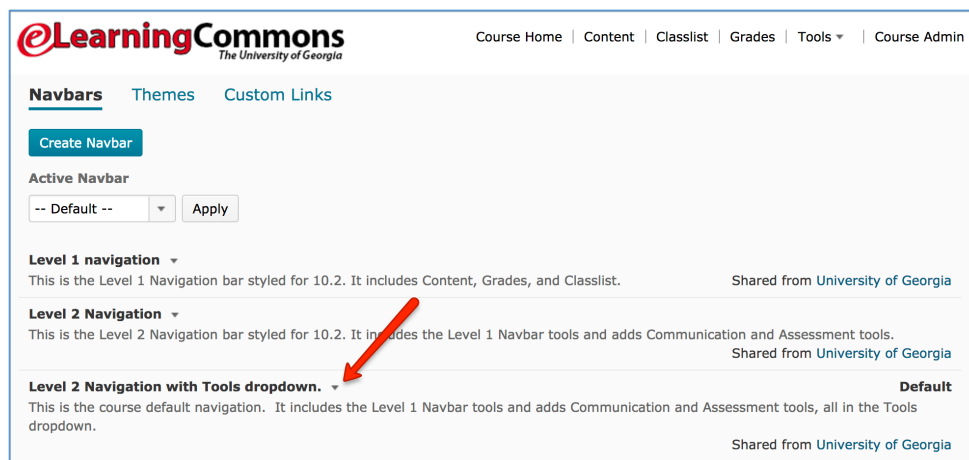


Beginning August 8, 2017, Blackboard Collaborate will be removed from the default eLC navigation bar. Collaborate Ultra is the preferred tool moving forward, but if you need to access Blackboard Collaborate, follow these instructions to add it back to your course navigation.

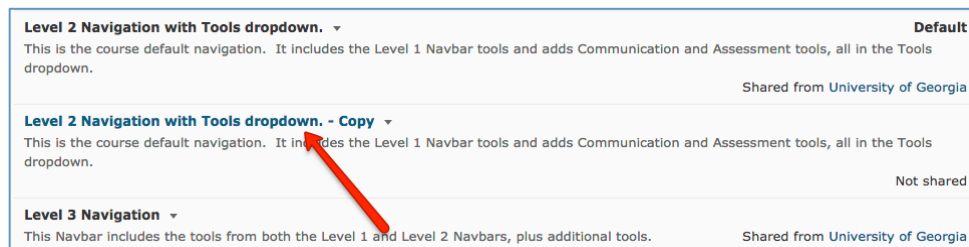
- Click Course Admin, then click Navigation and Themes.



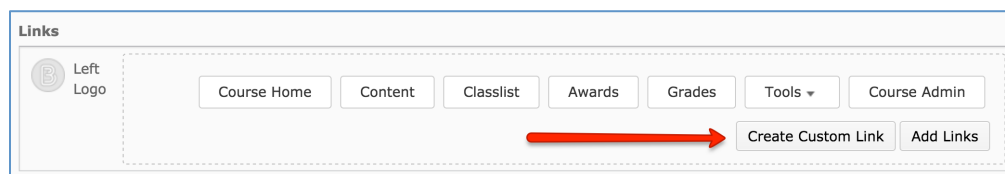
- To customize any of the navigation bars in the list, you must first make a copy of an existing one. Click the drop-down arrow next to the name of the navigation bar you want to copy, such as the Default, and click Copy.



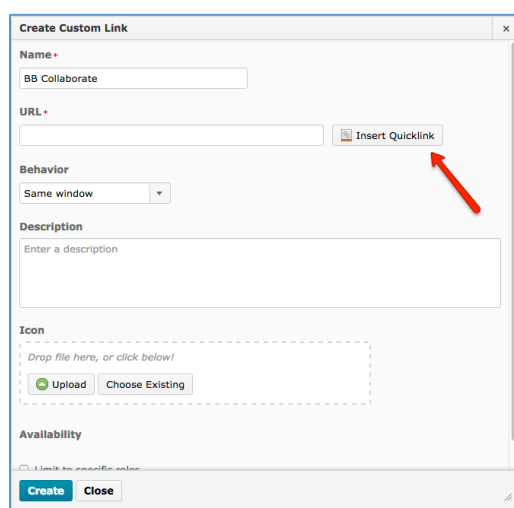
- Click on the newly created copy to begin customizing.



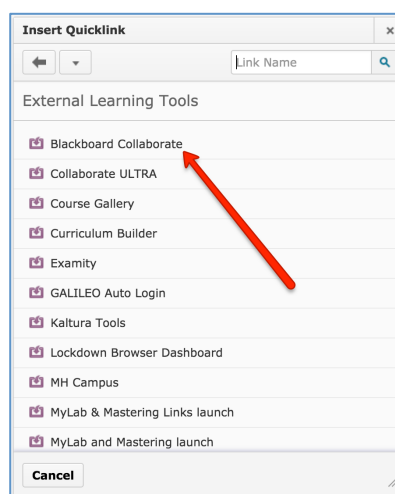
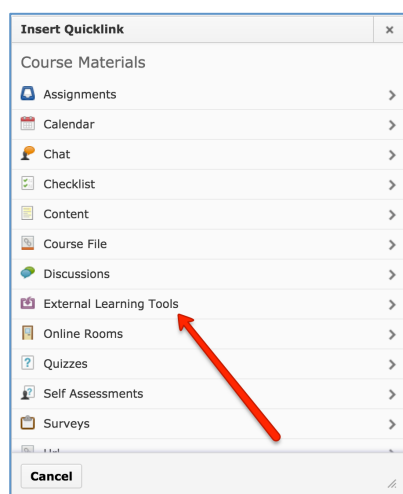
- Click Create Custom Link.




- Enter a name for the Link, such as BB Collaborate. Then, click Insert Quicklink.



- Click External Learning Tools, then Blackboard Collaborate.



- Click Create, then click Save and Close.
- Finally, make your newly customized NavBar active. Click the drop-down menu under Active NavBar, select your copy, then click Apply.
